IMPORTANT INFORMATION



We are tightening up on **security** and **safeguarding**, as you are aware, to ensure we provide **a safe school for your children**. Of course there will be teething problems and your support is appreciated. (Your comments are welcome in the comments box at main reception)



However while nearly all our parents are following the routines, and making sure their children are too, there are a small number who are still coming into school through classroom doors and ignoring requests from school.



Also some children are coming to school far too early. It has been reported to school that there are children on the road, causing a danger before the gates open at 8.50a.m.



Please do not let your child set off for school too early, as school staff are only available for supervision from 8.50a.m. You are responsible for your child's supervision until this time.

The routines have not changed we are just making sure they are being followed for **health and safety** and **safeguarding** requirements.



THE SCHOOL GATES OPEN AT 8.50 - This gives parents and carers 10 minutes to drop children at classroom doors and move from one part of the school grounds to the other. Only nursery children need to be taken into class. It is part of building independence, as well as safety, that the rest of the children come in by themselves.
